A \$2 million baseball park called 'Little Cubs Field' opened Saturday in Humboldt Park on the Northwest Side.

Complete with cheering fans, free hot dogs, music, politicians, and Cubs pitchers Angel Guzman and Carlos Marmol, this miniature Wrigley Field opened with the type of fanfare usually reserved for opening day at Clark and Addison.

This state-of-the-art, official Little League diamond features artificial turf, covered seating, lighting, dugouts, bullpens and an electric scoreboard. The field is 100% accessible to persons with disabilities.

Little Cubs Field was a collaborative project between the Chicago Cubs, the YMCA, the Chicago Park District and the Parkways Foundation.
