

Limited Tickets Available for '72 White Sox Tribute

For the first time since they surprised the baseball world and stabilized the franchise in one memorable season, 1972 White Sox will get their due at a Chicago Baseball Museum tribute on Monday, June 25. Attire will be business casual.

Limited tickets are available and can be purchased at Chicagobaseballmuseum.org.

Here's a guide to the event:

- The fundraising dinner will begin at 6 p.m. in the Stadium Club at U.S. Cellular Field. Complimentary parking will be available in Lot D and E near 37th and Princeton Ave.
- Doors will open at 5 p.m. for persons with tickets to the pre-event cocktail party. They will be eligible for one autograph per guest in the final 15 minutes as time permits.
- Team members Dick Allen, Tom Bradley, Rich Gossage, Roland Hemond, Bart Johnson, Carlos May, Bill Melton and Ed Spiezio are expected to attend the celebration. White Sox Interactive correspondent Mark Liptak and Sun-Times columnist-WLS radio host Richard Roeper will serve as the emcees.
- Tickets that were bought on or before Tuesday, June 19, will be distributed in the mail. Those purchased after that date can be picked up at the Stadium Club entrance on the night of the event.
- Each ticket will include two drink coupons to be distributed upon admittance. Additional coupons will be sold individually.
- Allen will throw the ceremonial first pitch prior to the game versus the Milwaukee Brewers at U.S. Cellular Field on Sunday, June 24. For ticket information, visit Whitesox.MLB.com
